**GREY SEAL:** These mammals spend most of their time out at sea feeding on fish. They return to land to rest! Being grey in colour, they often have a unique pattern of darker blotches and spots too.

**SHORE CRAB:** These crustaceans are normally a green-ish colour and are easily found in rock-pools. They love to eat most things including seaweed, mussels, barnacles and even smaller crabs!

**SHORT-EARED OWL:** This is an unusual owl because it prefers to be out and about in the daytime. It is most easily spotted in winter. Look out for it over moorlands and saltmarshes.

**LAPWING:** These birds with their distinctive "peewit" calls can often be seen wheeling through winter skies in large, black and white flocks. Look out for them over farmlands and wetlands.
